#### **General Guidance**

All items of clothing should be in a good state of repair and clearly marked with the pupil's name.

Shirt top buttons and ties are to be done up and shirts tucked in at all times.

Outdoor jackets may only be worn outside the buildings and are not permitted inside specifically in the classroom, dining room, during assembly or in Church. The optional Jacket can be worn around the site, pupils using their own jackets must stow them in lockers during the school day and not wear them around the College.

Hairstyles should not draw attention to the pupil. Styles must look natural and should not be dyed or bleached nor should bleaching products be used. Hair gel may be used in small amounts to maintain styles. Hair must be off the face, should be cut above the shoulder and not shaved lower than grade 2. No adornments are to be worn nor symbols shaved in. Long hair must be tied back for the safety and hygiene of the pupil. Boys must be clean shaven and sideburns kept short.

Apart from watches and approved religious wear, jewellery and piercings are not permitted. This is primarily for the safety in PE lessons, but also because loss or damage can cause distress.

The Headmaster reserves the right to make a final decision with regards to uniform, hairstyles or jewellery deemed to be unacceptable.
