Smart casual business wear. No hoodies, no sportswear, no trainers, no t-shirts, no offensive slogans or images. Example dress code: oxford shirt and chino's.

#### **General Guidance**

All items of clothing, bags and water bottles should be in a good state of repair and clearly marked with the pupil's name.

Shirt top buttons and ties are to be done up and shirts tucked in at all times.

Outdoor jackets may only be worn outside the buildings and are not permitted inside specifically in the classroom, dining room, during assembly or in Church. **Non-uniform jackets are not permitted.** 

Hairstyles should not draw attention to the pupil. Styles must look natural and should not be dyed or bleached nor should bleaching products be used. Hair gel may be used in small amounts to maintain styles. Hair must be off the face and not shaved lower than grade 2. No adornments are to be worn nor symbols shaved in. Long hair must be tied back for the safety and hygiene of the pupil. Pupil facial hair must be neat and well-kept.

Apart from watches and approved religious wear, jewellery and piercings are not permitted. Transfer tattoos/body art are not permitted except for religious festivals. This is primarily for the safety in PE lessons, but also because loss or damage can cause distress.

The Headteacher reserves the right to make a final decision with regards to uniform, hairstyles, jewellery and so forth deemed to be unacceptable.

All machine-washable items will be laundered on-site for Weekly and Termly boarders for which a charge is made and added as a Supplementary Charge. All clothing must be suitable for commercial washing and tumble drying. Designer items and those requiring hand washing cannot be catered for and should not be brought to College.
